## **Upcoming Events**


**July 6 - Monthly IMRG meeting and AMR Start & End at IMSD** KSU at 10:00 AM

### Thursday Night Rides -



#### **Closing Thoughts from the Editor -**

Each of us probably has a different story of why we choose to throw a leg over the saddle and roll down the open road not to mention the hours spent on keeping our machines tuned and clean in-between those rides. My story, which I have shared with a few, goes back to when Indian Motorcycles where made in Springfield, Massachusetts.

I myself grew up about 50 miles from Springfield in the Berkshire Hills of Western MA., where I was told stories by my grandfather of his Indian, a 1928 Scout 101. While I never saw the bike first hand, he would tell countless tales of himself and his bike including the one when he got a flat tire while delivering the mail. While having the tire fixed, he ended up making a date with the shops book keeper, a woman who later became my grandmother.

Even when things seem to go wrong, they turn out right when you ride an Indian. If you ever find yourself riding behind me and wonder what CFP1909 stands for on my plate, thats a tribute to my grandfather, Clifford Frank Peck, and the year he was born.
